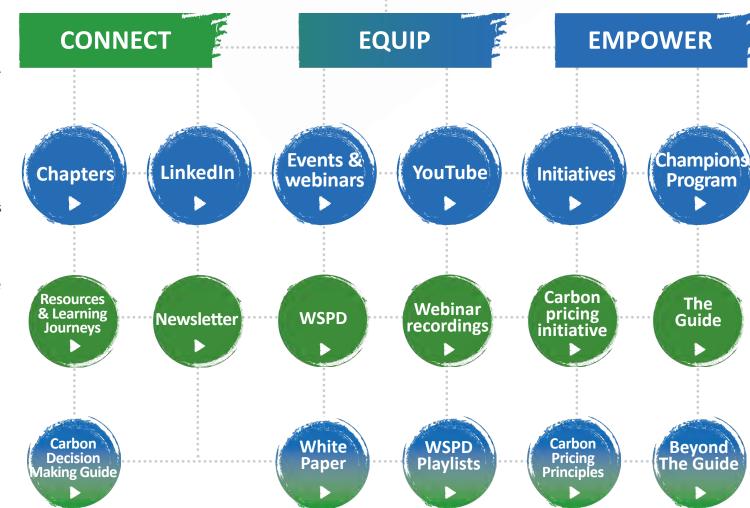

SPP initiatives: The Guide

Driving culture change for real-life collaborative procurement solutions





Global procurement leaders participating in the <u>Champions</u>
<u>Program</u> identified a critical gap: while sustainability ambitions were rising in 2023, practical insights on how to achieve them were missing. The call was for open exchange, honest reflection, and building a culture of collaboration.

Sustainability in procurement is complex, but we don't have to face it alone

The response was <u>The Guide</u> - a collaborative resource created by CPOs and participants of their team to accelerate learning and implementation. Unlike polished success stories, The Guide embraces

complexity, sharing failure and lessons learned, challenges faced, and scalable strategies across industries, regions and company sizes. It's led by procurement, for procurement, a signal of what's possible when we break silos and learn together.

The growing library of sustainable procurement case studies

Since its launch, The Guide has grown into a trusted engagement tool for chief procurement officers, their teams and suppliers. They use the case studies to spark dialogue, reach out to peers to learn more, and inspire action. The Guide started in 2023 with eight case studies complemented by five

additional cases in 2024 expanding the range of industries, regions, and topics. In 2025 the Guide stepped up a gear as more than 60 new case studies were added from across the SPP community. The surge in case studies and realworld examples was the result of a supplier engagement drive led by the SPP Pharma and Life Sciences Chapter.

We have named this new iteration and expansion 'Beyond The Guide

Deepdive'. And, as The Guide continues to evolve, it empowers procurement professionals to embrace sustainability with confidence, building a stronger collaborative approach in procurement globally.

SPP initiatives: Carbon **Pricing for Procurement**

Radical collaboration to turn sustainability into commercial success

A bold new chapter for our procurement community began in 2024. With the launch of the Carbon Pricing for Procurement Initiative, the SPP community set out to tackle one of the toughest challenges in supply chain decarbonization: how to bring carbon into the heart of commercial decision-making.

Built on peer-to-peer collaboration, the initiative gives procurement professionals a safe space to exchange ideas, test solutions, and cocreate practical guidelines to inspire the implementation of Carbon Pricing in procurement processes across industries.

The Initiative has been powered by the exceptional leadership of Haleon and Bayer, participants of the Champions Program, and developed in radical

collaboration with procurement leaders across industries, and partners including the **Scope 3** Peer Group.

It is not about perfection. It is about progress.

In this spirit, the initiative's first major milestone came in January 2025 with the release of the Carbon Pricing **Principles** — a framework designed by Procurement, for Procurement to embed carbon pricing directly into tender evaluation and supplier selection. By assigning a financial value to carbon emissions, the Principles create a new dynamic where suppliers with lower carbon footprints gain a real competitive edge, turning sustainability into a driver of commercial success. This achievement was only possible thanks to radical

collaboration across more than 200 industry leaders, CPOs. and practitioners who came together to share insights and cut through complexity.

The launch of the Principles laid the foundation for Phase 2, where companies stepped forward to pilot carbon pricing in their procurement processes, and share their experiences openly with peers. Adding further strength in 2025, Bain & Company has supported the initiative by facilitating collaboration and synthesizing insights from the Carbon Pricing Pilot Group, ensuring that learnings are captured and shared widely with the global procurement community.

The next big milestone? An updated version of the Principles, refined by the practical learnings from these

pilots and enriched with case studies to help others on their journey. This cycle of "design, test, share, improve" is what makes the initiative transformative: it is Procurement professionals rolling up their sleeves, experimenting together, and proving that collaboration can drive real, scalable change.

WSPD is a day of exchange and learning. Procurement leaders from across regions, topics and industries share insights, lessons, and solutions.

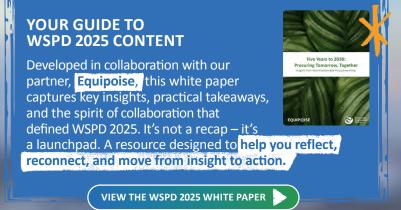
Thanks to the expertise of Caitlyn Lewis and her team, WSPD turned into a truly global, virtual event every year.

Chapter spotlight: collaborating at pace

Maria Terracina and Robert Williams, Co-chairs of the SPP Pharma & Life Sciences Chapter and active participants in the Champions Program through their companies Pfizer and AstraZeneca, recognised a shared challenge: how to engage more meaningfully with suppliers. Here is how they used the SPP space to find a collaborative solution:

What started as a shared need from two companies has led to a meaningful dialogue with suppliers and created a space to surface insights and to give back to the whole SPP community. Take inspiration from this initiative – build on it, tailor it to your needs, or launch similar efforts with your own procurement teams, peers, suppliers and partners.



Maria and Robert shared a common need: to engage with their suppliers to deliver more sustainable outcomes. And instead of tackling it alone in their companies, they leveraged the power of the SPP community.

Inspired by The Guide - an initiative launched by the SPP Champions Program in 2023 - they called suppliers to take action as part of the Pharma & Life Sciences Chapter. The idea was to share sustainability journeys - what's worked, what hasn't, and what's next.

The response was bigger than anyone expected: over 70 suppliers stepped up offering insights from their sustainability experiences.

From that pool, the best <u>six</u> <u>case studies</u> were selected and the suppliers presented their journey to the SPP community.

More than 50 case studies were then chosen for <u>Beyond</u>
<u>The Guide Deepdive: Pharma</u>
& Life Sciences Supply Chain

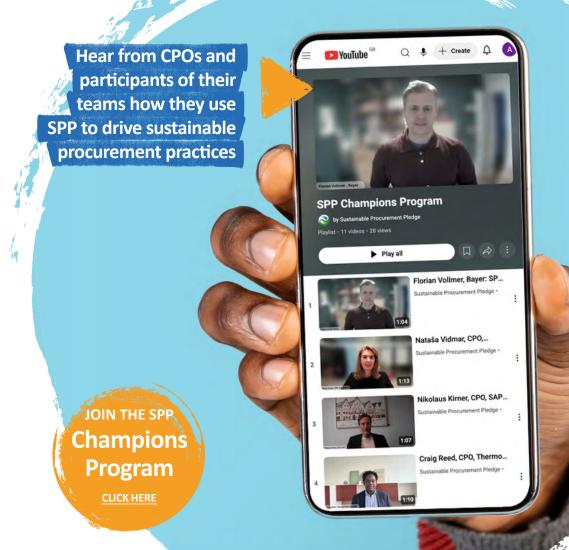
